

8. I pray that my kids will bear the fruit of the Spirit. Gal 5:22—23 *But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control; against such things there is no law.*

9. I pray that my kids will live by the Spirit and not satisfy their flesh. Gal 5:16 *But I say, walk by the Spirit, and you will not gratify the desires of the flesh.*

10. I pray that my kids will desire and be drawn to the right kind of friends and be protected from the wrong kind. Pro 1:10,15 *My son, if sinners entice you, do not consent. My son, do not walk in the way with them; keep your foot from their paths,*

11. I pray that my kids will not be involved with the wrong mate and will choose and be saved for the right one. 2Co 6:14 *Do not be unequally yoked with unbelievers. For what partnership has righteousness with lawlessness?*

12. I pray that both my kids and future spouse will be kept pure until marriage. 1Co 6:16 –18 *...For, as it is written, "The two will become one flesh." But he who is joined to the Lord becomes one spirit with him. Flee from sexual immorality. Every other sin a person commits is outside the body, but the sexually immoral person sins against his own body.*

13. I pray that my children will recognize the voice of the Father and quickly respond to it. I Sam 15:22b *Behold, to obey is better than sacrifice! To listen better than the fat of rams! Jam 1:22 But become doers of the Word, and not hearers only, deceiving your own selves.*

14. I pray that my kids will learn to submit totally to God and actively resist Satan in all circumstances.

Jas 4:7 Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you.

15. I pray that my kids will be single-hearted, willing to be sold out to Jesus. Rom 12:1 –2 *I appeal to you therefore, ... to present your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and acceptable to God, which is your reasonable service. Do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewal of your mind, that you may prove what is that good and acceptable and perfect will of God.*

16. I pray that my kids will have quick, repentant hearts. Psa 51:1-3 *Have mercy on me, O God, according to your steadfast love; according to your abundant mercy blot out my transgressions. Wash me thoroughly from my iniquity, and cleanse me from my sin! For I know my transgressions, and my sin is ever before me.*

17. I pray that my kids will honour their parents so that all may go well with them. Eph 6:1-2 *See Promises.*

18. I pray that my kids will trust the Lord for direction in their lives, including their occupation. Pro 3:5—6 *Trust in the LORD with all your heart, and do not lean on your own understanding. In all your ways acknowledge him, and he will make straight your paths.*

19. I pray that my kids will discern between good and evil. 1Ki 3:11 –12 *"Because you have asked ... for yourself understanding to discern what is right, behold, I now do according to your word. Behold, I give you a wise and discerning mind, so that none like you has been before you and none like you shall arise after you.*

20. I pray that my kids will live full and overflowing lives. John 10:10b *I have come so that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly.*

3. **I pray that my kids will be blessed in all their interpersonal relationships.** *Dan. 6:3 "Then this Daniel began distinguishing himself among the commissioners and satraps because he possessed an extraordinary spirit, and the king planned to appoint him .*

4. **I pray that my kids find favour with both God and man.** *Pro 3:4 So you will find favor and good success in the sight of God and man.*

5. **I pray that my kids will respect those in authority over them.** *Rom 13:1 Let every person be subject to the governing authorities. For there is no authority except from God, and those that exist have been instituted by God.*

6. **I pray that my kids's sin will be revealed.** *Psa 119:71 It is good for me that I was afflicted, that I might learn your statutes.*

7. **I pray that my kids will be teachable and able to take correction.** *Isa 54:13 See Promises Pro 13:1 A wise son hears his father's instruction, but a scoffer does not listen to rebuke.*
